





Bid Evaluation Report

1. Name of Procuring Agency: School Education & Literacy Department, Government of Sindh with assistance of Public Private Partnership Unit, Finance Department, Government of Sindh.

2. Tender Reference No: [T000641-17-0004]

3. Tender Description/Name of work/item: The Government aims to contract credible Education Management Organizations (EMOs) from the Private Sector to manage and improve the functioning of public schools by introducing innovation's, modernizing the education system, addressing management gaps, maintaining and upgrading the school building facilities, and cooperatively working along with teachers, school staff, school management committees, surrounding communities and local tiers of the School Education and Literacy Department (the "Project"). In order to improve the standard of education the province of Sindh, the Government, acting through the Authority, envisages a Public Private Partnership (PPP) model, for the introduction of EMO's in Sindh.

The Project is an important part of the Governments Strategy towards developing Sindh's Education Sector and improving the Literacy rate. In 2013, the Government of Sindh passed the Sindh Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act in compliance with Article 25-A of the Constitution of Pakistan. The legislation has placed a renewed obligation on the Government of Sindh, including the Authority, to take steps to address the weak performance of the education sector. Accordingly, the public schools managed and run by the EMOs will function under the given constitutional provisions and the aforesaid Act passed thereafter. The Education in such public schools will remain free of charge for all the students. The admission process will be strictly nondiscriminatory and as per the spirit mentioned in the statute law.


