NOTIFICATION

No.SO(G)/U&B/GEN/S.C/SELD/2020: In pursuance of the 1-A of the Section 12 of Sindh Board of Technical Education Ordinance of 1970 and Sub-Section 1-A of the Section 11 of the Sindh Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education Ordinance of 1972 (Amendment) Act 2020 passed by the Sindh Assembly published in Government Gazette, the Government of Sindh in Cabinet meeting dated 22nd July, 2020 has approved Policy for the promotion of students of Secondary and Higher Secondary Schools (SSC Part-I & II and HSC Part-I & II).

A. Promotion of Technical Vocational Education & Training (TVET) Candidates under Sindh Board of Technical Education Ordinance of 1970 (Amended) Act 2020

- i) Technical School Certificate (TSC) is equivalent to SSC examination; hence. Promotion policy for class 9 & 10 shall be applicable to TSC.
- ii) All Diploma Courses are equivalent to HSC examination; hence promotion policy of class 11 & 12 shall be applicable to all Diploma Courses.
- iii) Practical examination of Competency-Based Training shall be conducted in September 2020 in small groups.

B. Promotion of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education-Class 9th to 11th and 10th & 12th Candidates under Sindh Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education Ordinance (Amended) Act 2020

- I. All regular and private candidates appearing in class 9 & 11 examination shall be promoted to class 10 & 12. Marks of class 9 & 11 examination shall be awarded based on their performance in class 10 & 12 examination in 2021 with an increase of 3% marks of their obtained score in class 10 or 12 examination (e.g. 300 marks in class 10 or 12 examination 2021 and 300 marks in class 9 and 11 examination 2020 with 3% increase in marks" 300+309 total 609 marks).
- II. All regular and private candidates appearing in class 10 & 12 examination shall be declared pass based on their class 9 & 11 examination result with an increase of 3% marks in their respective examination result (i.e Class 10 & 12).
- III. Regular and private failure candidates re-appearing in class 10 & 12 examination:
 - a) Failed/absent candidates in two subjects and secured more than 60% marks in their pass subjects shall be awarded average marks based on their obtained score.
 - b) The remaining failure candidates shall be awarded passing marks in order to declare them pass.
 - c) Those failure candidates who wish to opt for re-appearing in their fail subjects in the special examination subject to normalcy, they shall have to apply to their respective Boards.

- IV. Candidates appearing in class 10 & 12 examination but failed/absent in their practical, they shall be given average score based on their previous practical marks.
- V. Candidates who applied for improving their result of class 11 & 12 examination shall be given 3% increase of marks in their respective subjects for improvement. In case, those who wish to opt for re-appearing in the special examination subject to normalcy, they shall have to apply to their respective Boards.
- VI. Candidates who applied for seeking additional qualification/changing their subjects/groups shall be given additional 3% marks in their respective subjects. In case, those who wish to opt for re-appearing in the special examination subject to normalcy, they shall have to apply to their respective Boards.
- VII. Regular and private candidates shall be provided transcript/ marks certificate of class 10 & 12 examination:
a) Shall carry aggregate score and not the score of individual subjects with overall grade of theory and practical based on the students' last examination result.
b) An overall merit of the candidates shall be maintained but the candidates shall not be awarded first three positions since they have not appeared in their respective examination and have been declared pass.
- VIII. Transcripts/Marks Certificates shall contain the following FOOTNOTE:
The regular and private candidates promoted/declared pass due to the outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic and the marks awarded for SSC / HSC Annual Examination 2020 (Part I&II) is the best prediction of candidates' performance and formulae and guidelines approved vide (amended) Act of 2020 adopted by the Sindh Board of Technical Education and Sindh Education Boards and recognized by the Inter Boards Committee of Chairmen (IBCC).

All the public sector Educational Boards shall initiate action under the Act immediately.
